

How to Download Hot Potatoes for PC

1. In your browser, go to <http://hotpot.uvic.ca/>
2. Scroll down and click “Hot Potatoes 6.3 Installer”

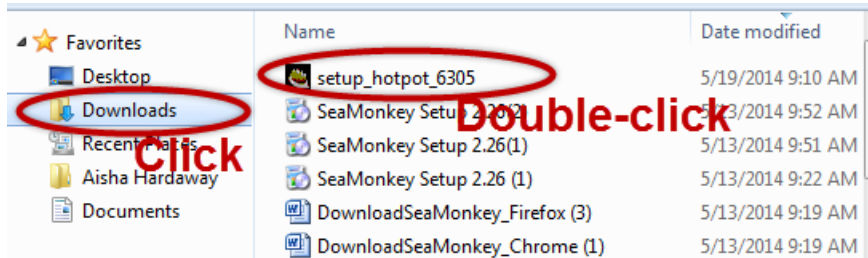
Download Hot Potatoes for Windows from here:

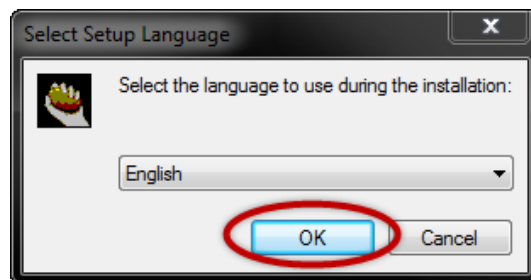
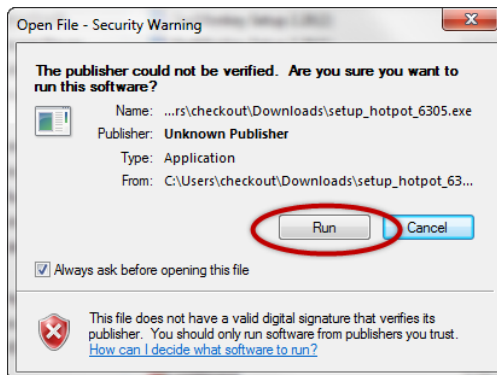
Download Java Hot Potatoes:

- [Download Java Hot Potatoes](#) which will run on Mac OS X, Windows, Linux or Virtual Machine. To install and run Java Hot Potatoes on Mac OS X:

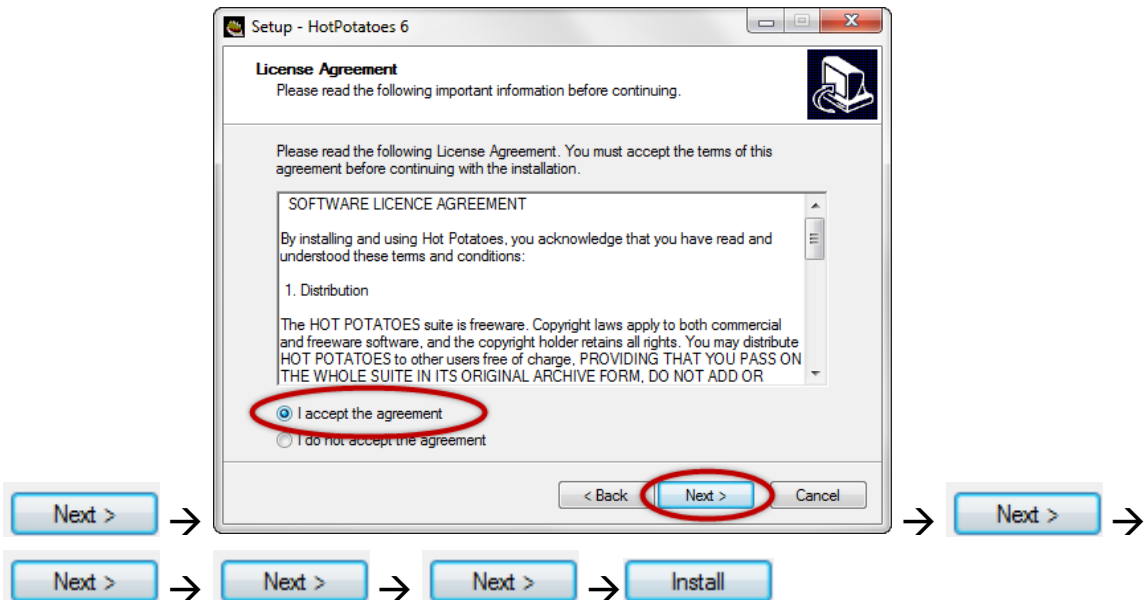
3. The link will automatically start downloading a file to your Downloads folder. Click the Windows Explorer icon in the bottom left corner of your screen, then go to your Downloads folder and find the file. Double-click the “setup_hotpot_6305” file.



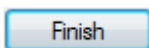
4. Click “Run,” make sure the language is your preferred one and click “OK.”



5. Click “Next,” then click “I accept the agreement” and “Next” again, then “Next” again, then “Next” again, then “Next” again, then “Next” one more time, then “Install.” **Note: there are five “Next” buttons and one “Install button here. Do not forget to click “I accept” at the second “Next” button, or it will not allow you to move on through the setup.**



6. Click “Finish,” and then you are done with the Hot Potatoes installation. You can now move on to the Hot Potatoes for PC instructions.
