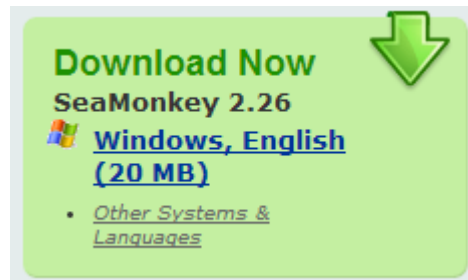
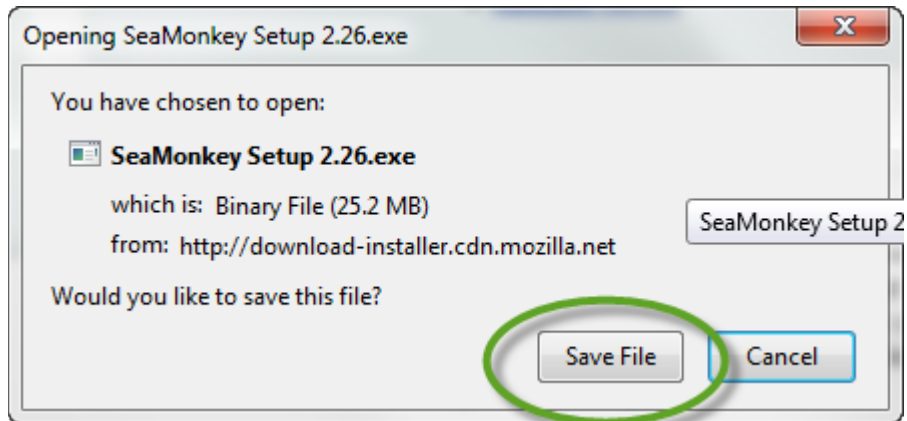


# Downloading SeaMonkey in Firefox

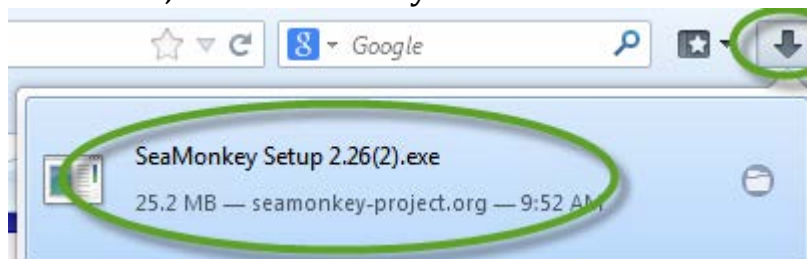
1. Go to [www.seamonkey-project.org](http://www.seamonkey-project.org), and in the green box it should say your operating system and language. If this is correct, click the link. If it says something different, click “Other Systems & Languages” and find your respective language and OS.



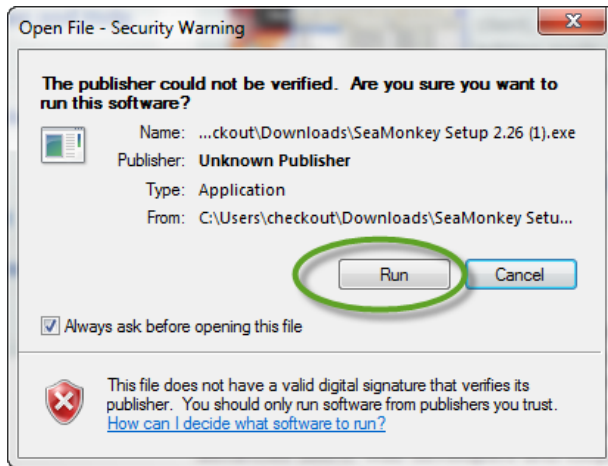
2. On Windows, a window will show up that looks like the one below. Click “Save File.”



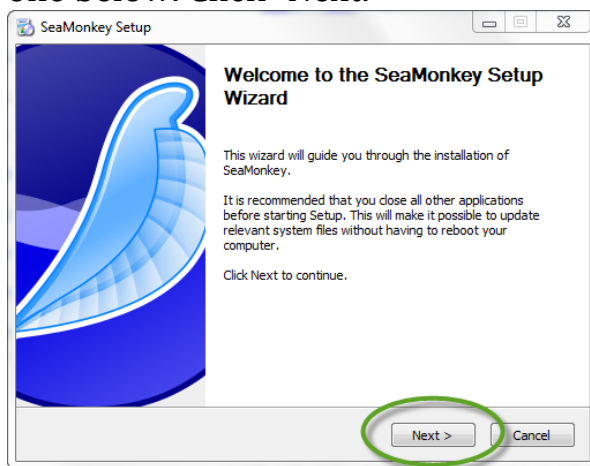
The arrow in the top right corner of the screen will turn green. Click on it, and then click your file.



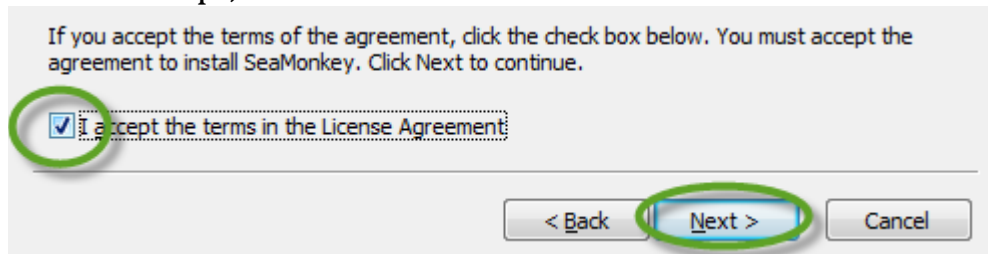
You will next get a window that looks like the one below. Click “Run.”



When it is done loading, you will get a window that looks like the one below. Click “Next.”

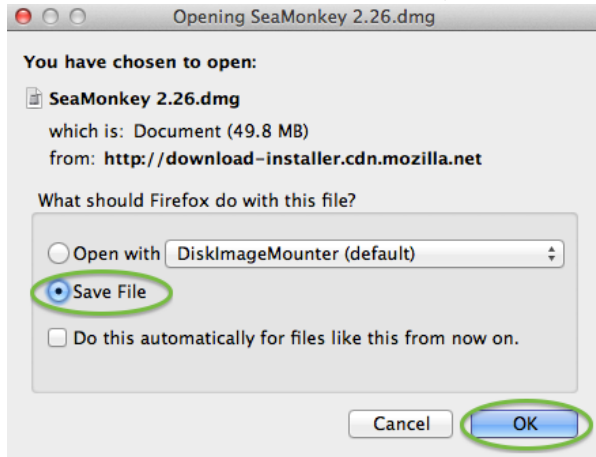


Click “I accept,” then click “Next.”



Click “Next” again, then click “Install.” When it has finished loading, click “Finish.”

3. On Mac, a window will appear that looks like the one below. Click the “Save File” radio button, then click “OK.”



4. On Mac, the Downloads icon will jump in the lower right corner of the screen when it is done. Click the Downloads icon, then click the “SeaMonkey 2.26” file.



A window will show up that looks like the one below. Click and drag the SeaMonkey icon into the Applications folder, then exit the window.
