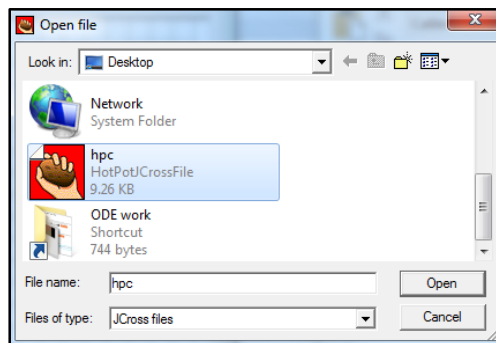
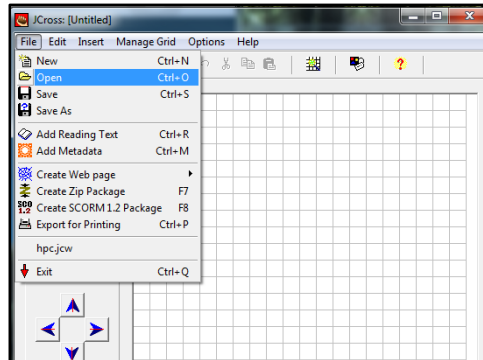
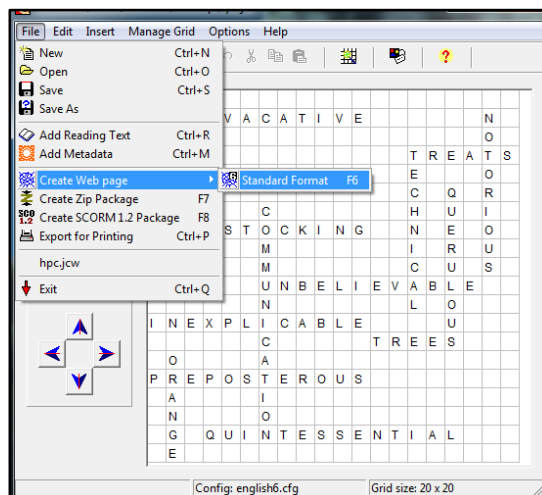


# Getting Hot Potatoes into D2L

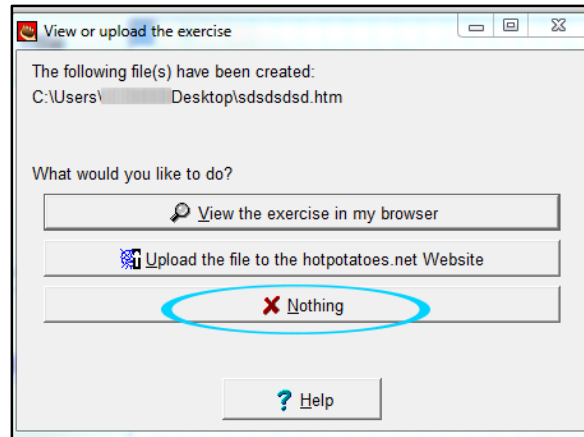
1. If you saved your Hot Potatoes item as an html file, skip to step 2. If you saved it as something else, continue with this step.
  - a. Open up the Hot Potatoes program and click on the type of item you created: for this example, I click on JCross because I made a crossword puzzle.
  - b. Click "File" then "Open." Find your file (it will have a "hand holding a potato" icon), click on it, and click "Open."



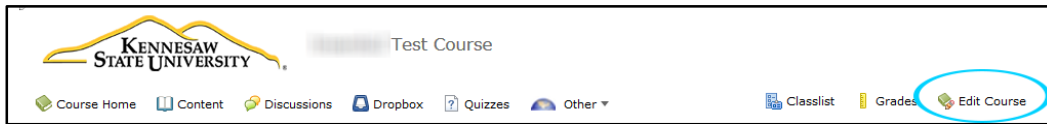
- c. Click "File" then "Create Web Page" then slide the cursor over and click "Standard Format."



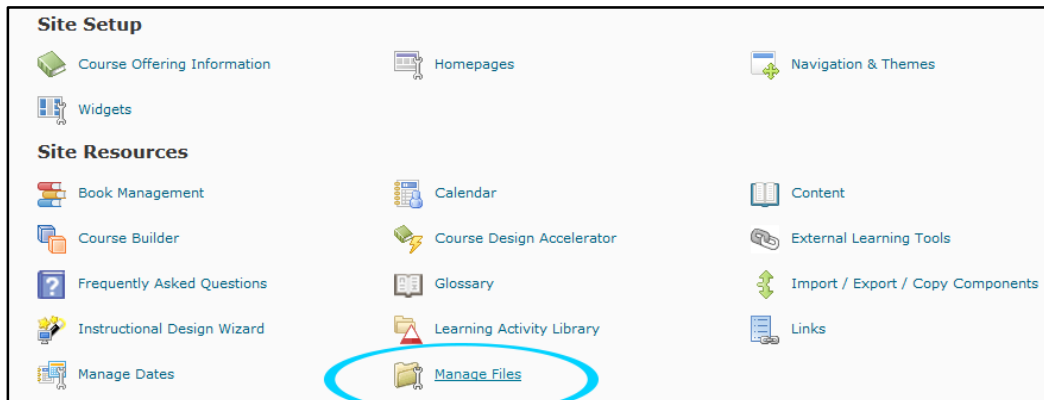
- d. Give your file a name and click “Save.” A pop-up will appear after the file is saved, asking what you want to do next. Just click “Nothing” and close out the program.



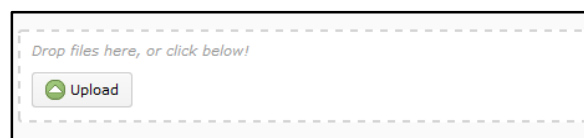
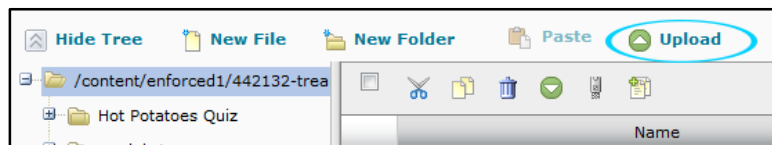
2. In your D2L course, click “Edit Course.”



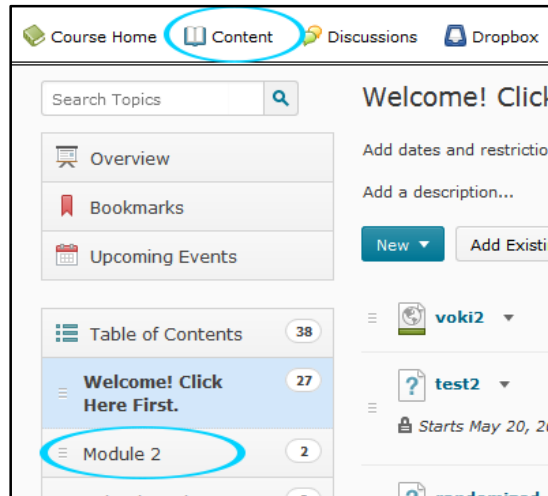
3. Click “Manage Files” under “Site Resources.”



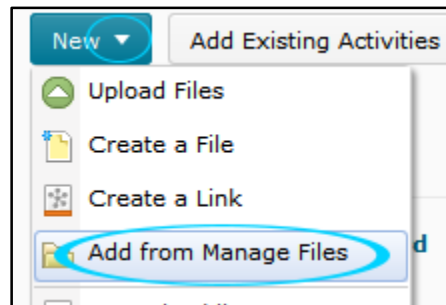
4. Click “Upload” at the top of your files list and then click “Upload” again to find your file.



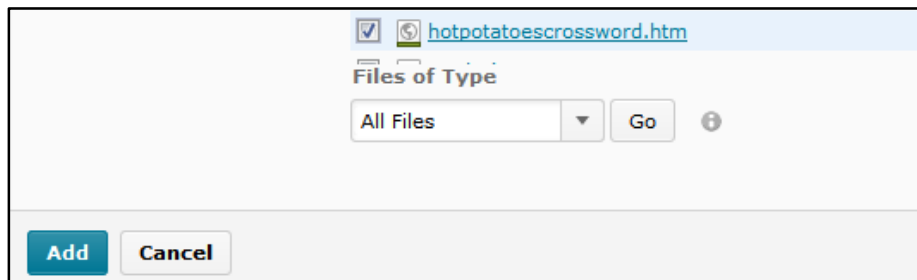
5. Click on your file, click “Open,” and click “Save.”
