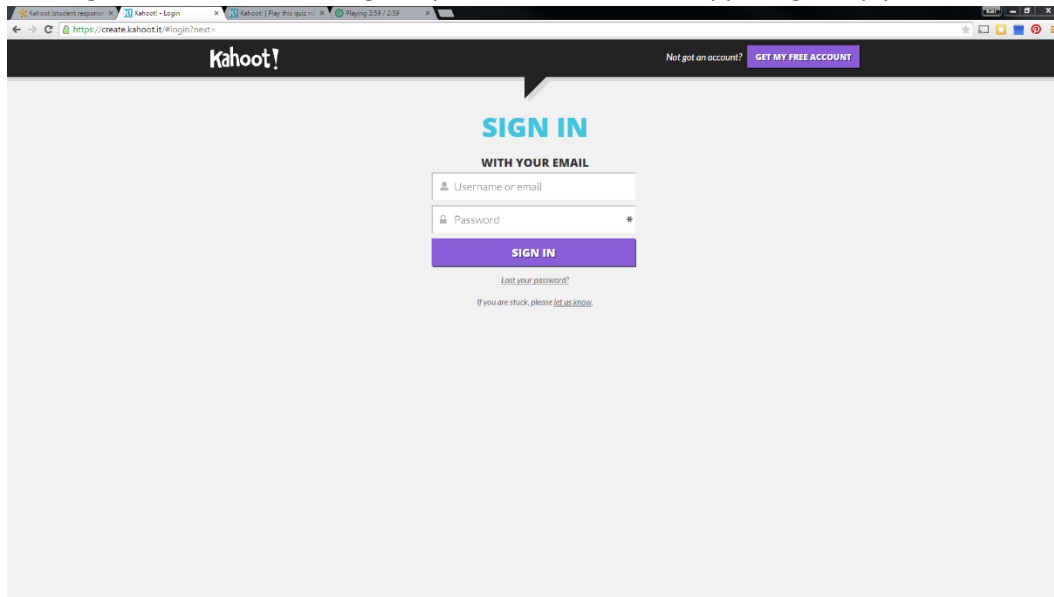
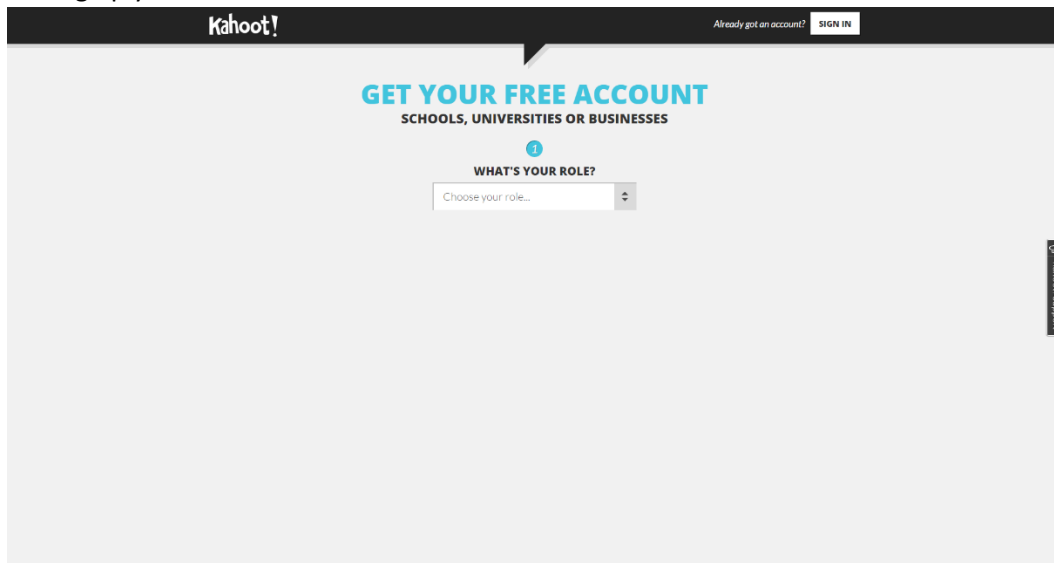


# Making a Kahoot

1. To begin, go to [getkahoot.com](https://getkahoot.com) or [create.kahoot.it](https://create.kahoot.it). You will be prompted to login if you have an existing account. If not, click “get my free account” in the upper right top portion of the screen.

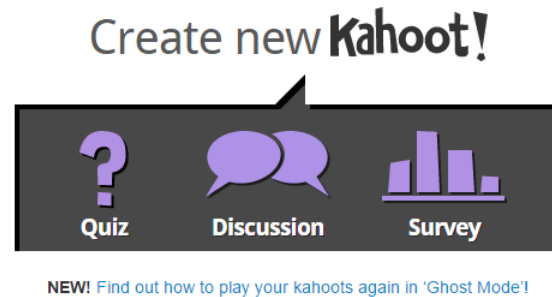


2. If you are creating an account for the first time you will be taken to the screen below prior to setting up your account.






3. Once you have selected how you plan to use Kahoot, fill in all the information and click “Create Account.”

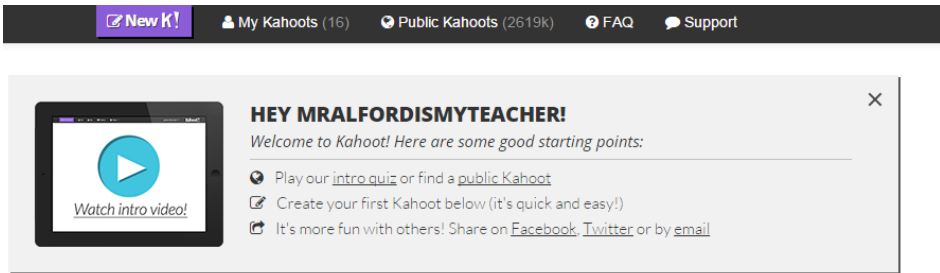
4. The first page you come to after setting up your account will have several options for setting up your Kahoot.



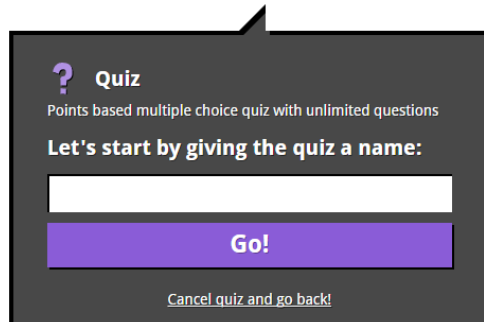
The different options are described below:

 <b>Quiz</b>	<p>Quiz is the traditional game style Kahoot where students compete against one another for points.</p>
 <b>Survey</b>	<p>Survey is very similar to quiz, however it does not tabulate scores or require that you designate a response(s) as correct.</p>
 <b>Discussion</b>	<p>Discussion can be used to spur or facilitate a class discussion. Similarly to survey, no score is taken and you did not need to designate as response as correct. This option limits responses to two.</p>

5. Let's choose Quiz. The next screen will ask you to name your Kahoot. Click "Go!" after doing so.

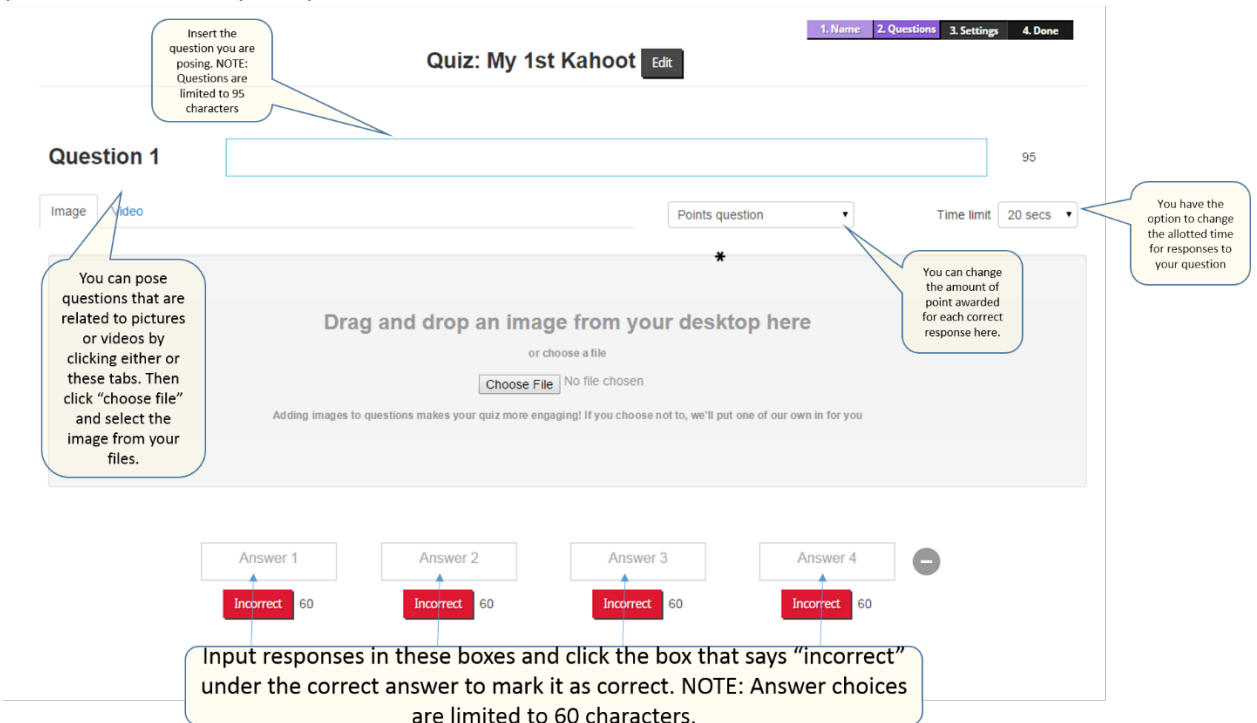

6. Creating each question will bring you to the screen below. Repeat the steps for each question you want to add to your quiz.



7. Once you have completed your question and designated a correct answer, click the appropriate box below.

	If you want to add a duplicate version of the current question.
	If you want to cancel the current Kahoot quiz.
	If you are finished adding questions to your Kahoot quiz and finished making edits.
