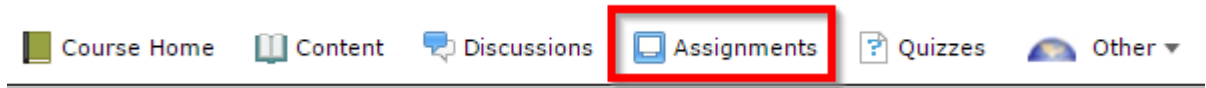




Turnitin Feedback Studio – Students


1. In your course, go to your assignments tab.



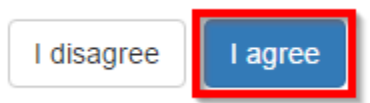
2. Next to the paper assignment you want to view the feedback for, click “View” under Feedback.

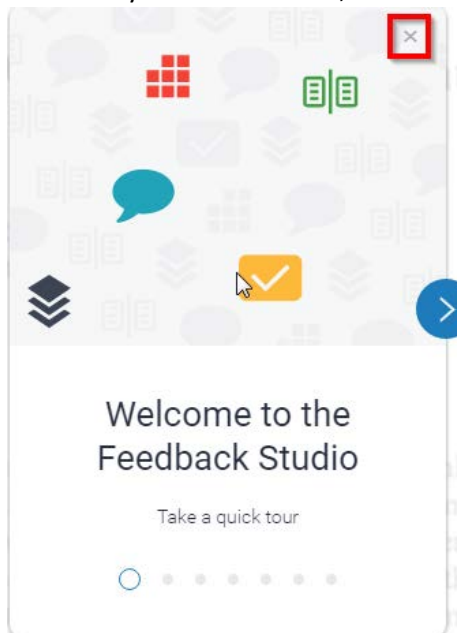

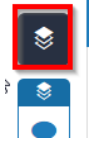
4. The first time you enter Turnitin Feedback Studio, you may be asked to agree to the user agreement. Make sure you click I agree.



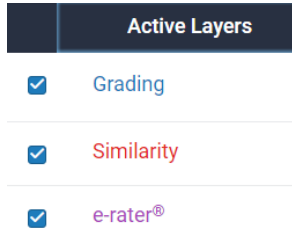
5. The first time you enter Turnitin Feedback Studio, you can take a tour of it by clicking the arrows. If you don't want to, click the x in the corner.



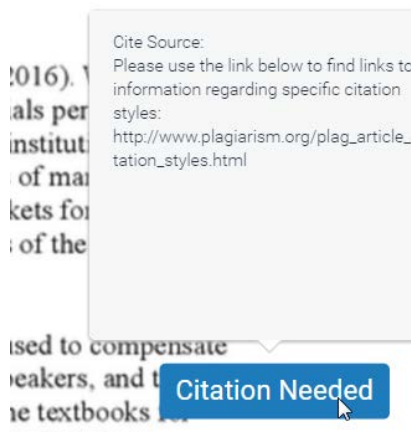
6. On the right side of the page, you will see the overall feedback from your instructor. This may be in the form of a rubric, a text comment, or a recorded voice comment. After you view those, click the layers button.



Check all of the boxes shown to see all feedback.



7. If you scroll down the page of your paper, you will see comments throughout the page in the places your instructor put them. Click a comment to see an expanded explanation.



8. If you click the match overview button, you will see your similarity report. Reviewing this will help you understand the similarity percentage you got on your paper.
