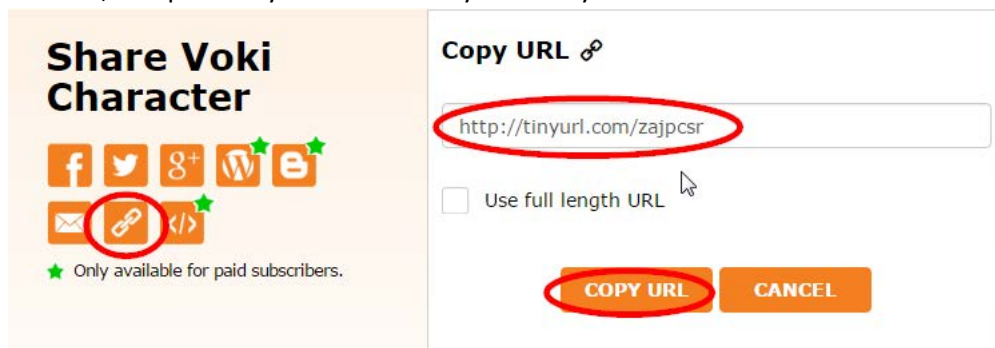


Getting Voki into D2L

Voki would work well for creating brief audible instructions for an assignment, or a brief explanation. To share a Voki that you have made, you'll want to upload it to D2L as a page of its own.

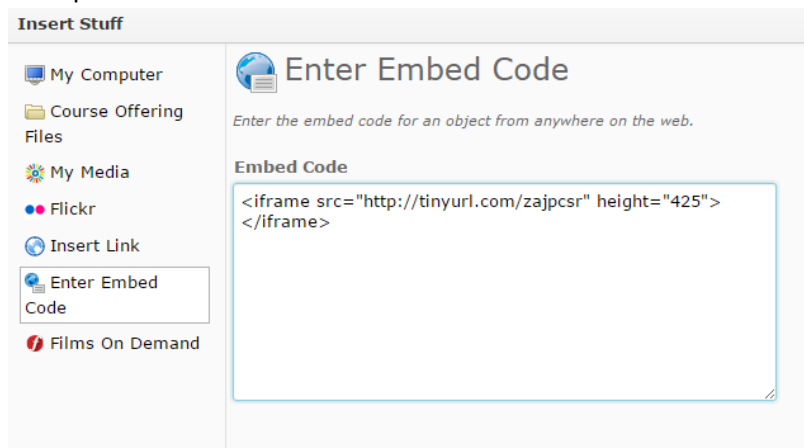
1. Once you've made your Voki, you are given the option to share via Facebook, Twitter, Google+, email, and a link. Voki used to give the option to embed with the free account, but they have recently revoked that permission. To link your Voki in D2L, you will click the URL button, copy the URL, and put it in your course like you do any link.



2. Even though Voki doesn't give you an embed code, you can still do it using HTML. If you want to embed, you will save that URL, then go to your D2L course, create a file, and follow the same instructions to embed any other item (Insert Stuff, then Enter Embed Code).
3. In the embed code box, type the following:

```
<iframe src="YOUR URL HERE" height="425"></iframe>
```

4. When you save it, you should see your Voki. Note that embedded items sometimes do not work in Google Chrome, so try viewing it in Firefox.
